- 3 hard covered composition notebooks; 80+ pages (1 english, 1 social studies, 1 math)
- 1 spiral notebook for math homework
- 1 two-pocket, 3 hole-punched folder (world language)
- Homework assignment pad or planner to record assignments
- Supply of blue/black pens
- Pencils (two boxes to begin year) probably more as year continues
- Erasers eraser caps too
- Highlighters (assorted colors; 4-5)
- 4 glue sticks
- Editing/correcting pen: red, green, or purple
- Small personal pencil sharpener
- 3x3 Post-It-Notes (solid, light colors)
- 1 box of colored pencils (needed for social studies and science)
- Earbuds or inexpensive headphones (student participating in world language should also have earbuds with a microphone for computer-based speaking activities.
